



University of Nairobi

The origins of the University of Nairobi dates back to 1947. However, it was in 1961 that the Royal Technical College was transformed into the Royal College Nairobi and in 1964 renamed to University college of Nairobi. In 1963, the University of East Africa was inaugurated with the University College of Nairobi a constituent College. In 1970, the University of East Africa was dissolved and University of Nairobi was then set up by an Act of Parliament.

This project is hosted by the Department of Public Health Pharmacology and Toxicology which is a department in the Faculty of Veterinary medicine which was set up in the then Royal University College Nairobi in 1962.
